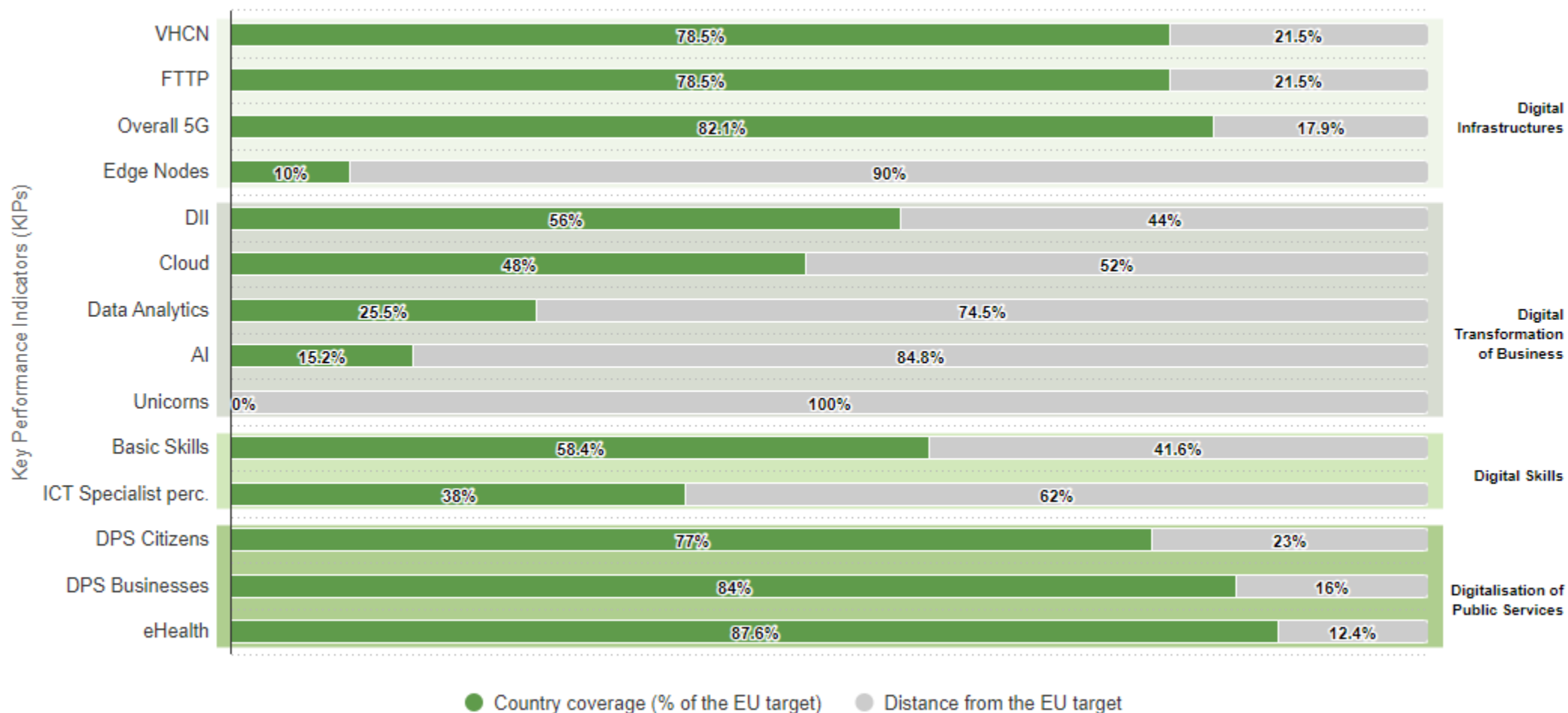

Basic digital skills – scope to improve performance

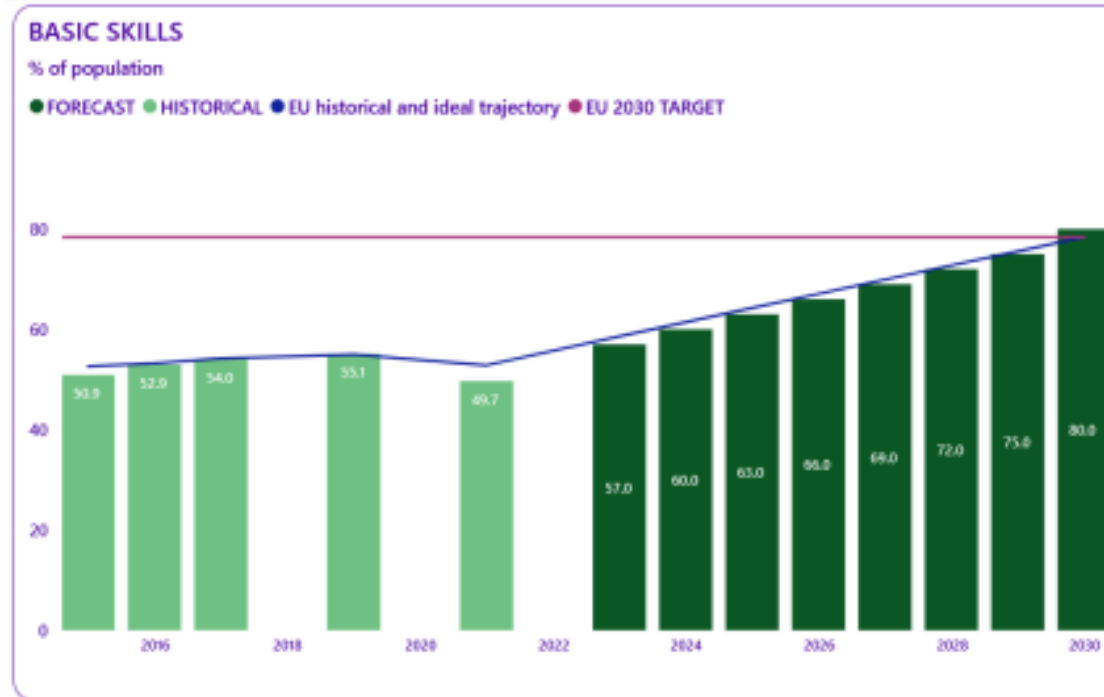
Slovenia's Roadmap

Recommendation to Slovenia¹

Accelerate efforts in the area of basic digital skills through an **increased and intensified offer** and **collaboration between public and private actors**.

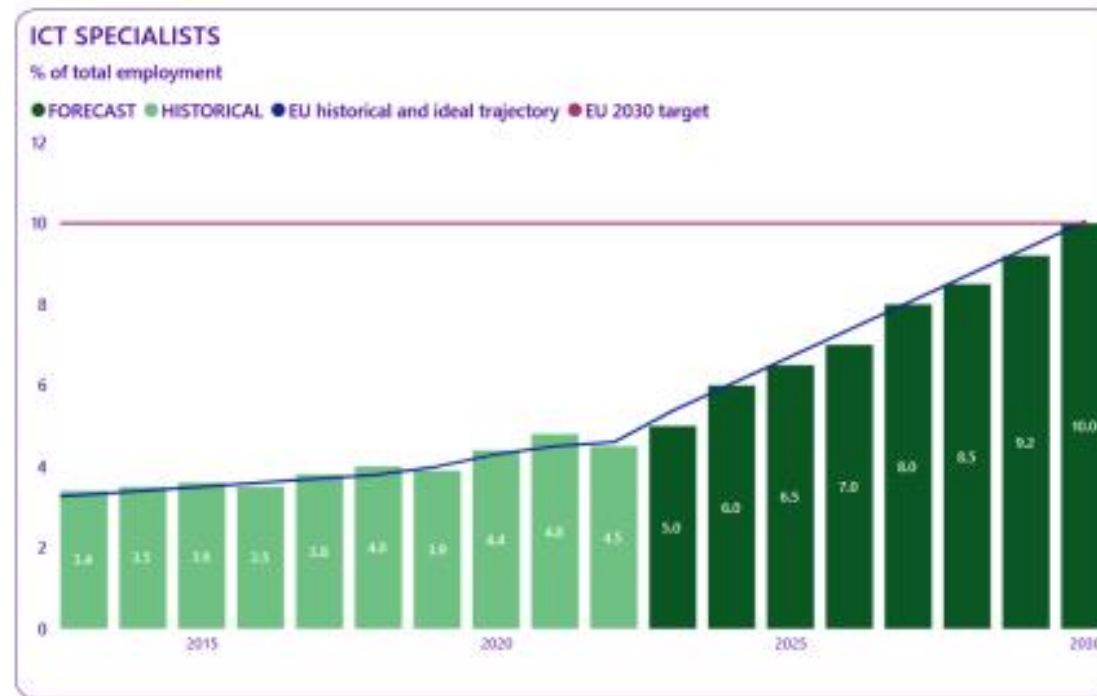
ICT specialists – scope to improve performance

Slovenia's Roadmap

One of the targets with the **fewest measures** and the **smallest budget**. Does **not** seem to be **sufficient to meet demand** for ICT specialists

Recommendation to Slovenia¹

- Strengthen **early identification** of **labour market needs** and react swiftly, especially in digital **upskilling and reskilling**
- Adapt (higher) education **curricula**
- Strengthen **collaboration** between relevant parties
